<p>Create a landscape drawing using different tones and shades</p> <p><i>Art</i></p>	<p>If you were to meet God, and have a conversation, what would you talk to him about?</p> <p><i>RE</i></p>	<p>Explain what the following forces are, in full sentences: Gravity, Air resistance, Water resistance, Friction and up thrust.</p> <p><i>Science</i></p>
<p>Make a model of a globe. <i>(Geography)</i></p>	<p>Research one of the Chinese Dynasties that interests you and write some interesting facts about what you have found out. You could include drawings as well</p> <p><i>(History)</i></p>	<p>Whilst you're reading, note down 5-10 words that you don't know and use a dictionary to define them.</p> <p><i>English</i></p>
<p>Create a moving mechanism using resources you have at home, for example, straws, kitchen roll tubes etc</p> <p><i>Science</i></p>	<p>Revise the column multiplication method. Multiply 3 digit numbers x 2 digit numbers. E.g. 673 x 42</p> <p><i>Maths</i></p>	<p>Investigate trade links and explain: What they are, who we have them with and why</p> <p><i>Topic (Geography)</i></p>
