Religious Education

EYFS

Value: appreciate different religious and cultural communities around them and across the world.

Year 1

Stories: Recall a variety of religious stories.

Belief: Give some examples of why stories, beliefs and places are important.

Discuss: Take part in discussions about own experiences within own families and link learning to own lives.

Year 2

Stories: Retell a selection of key stories and discuss their importance.

Belief: Give examples of the festivals and rituals that link to key religions and beliefs.

Discuss: Ask questions about different faiths and beliefs and make links to own lives.

Year 3

Belief: Give examples of how the beliefs of a faith affect the lives of believers.

Practice: Identify the key practices of a faith and the similarities and differences between religions.

Discuss: Link learning to own lives and discuss experiences within own families.

Year 4

Belief: Identify how the beliefs of different faiths help believers understand God.

Practice: Suggest how rituals, stories and prayer might make a difference to the way people live their lives.

Discuss: Talk about the similarities and differences between religions and how these link to their own lives.

Year 5

Belief: Describe ways in which beliefs help meet the needs of their own communities and the wider world.

Discuss: Discuss how beliefs change and influence the lives of believers.

Reflect: Reflect on the relevance of learning to their own lives and families.

Year 6

Belief: Describe and show understanding of how beliefs influence behaviour and practice.

Discuss: Raise questions about the key ideas from faiths that help or inspire believers' life choices.

Reflect: Ask questions about different faiths and reflect on how beliefs link to their own lives.
