PSHE Curricular Goals

EYFS

Empathy: show empathy to those around them.

Determination: show determination to reach a goal.

Resilience: show resilience when faced with challenges.

Curiosity: show curiosity in the world around them

Year 1

Feelings: Give examples of how to deal with 'not so good' feelings and how to help others to do this.

Explain: give explanations as to why things can seem unfair to others.

Understand: Give examples of caring for self and the environment at school and at home.

Year 2

Determination: Explain how setting goals help to reach achievements.

Difference: Know and use good listening skills and explain how they help understand different points of view.

Self-Regulation: Co-operate and understand self regulation and that of others.

Year 3

Empathy: understand what makes a good friend and help others who have fallen out.

Difference: Value different community groups.

Understand: understand the dangers of risks.

Year 4

Self-care: Explain the benefits of looking after myself now and in the future.

Challenge: Understand why we can challenge stereotypes.

Influence: express examples of things that can influence me when making decisions.

Year 5

Independence: discuss the increasing levels of independence and responsibilities people gain as they get older.

Change: List ways that can help prepare for change.

Influence: Give examples of things that might influence a person to take risks online.

Year 6

Compromise: give examples of negotiation and compromise.

Puberty: understand some of the emotional changes associated with puberty.

Safety: explain why and how to stay safe online and understand media bias including social media.
