Access All Arts is a nationwide week when children across the country celebrate the arts, building creativity, skills and confidence along the way.

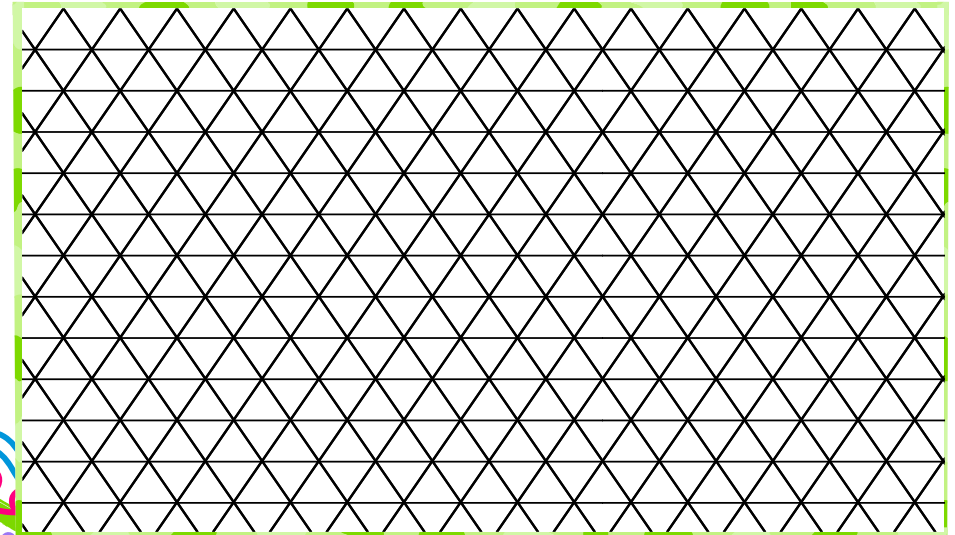
