Spelling Expectations	Practise spellings for 10 minutes each day. Children will be tested each Thursday. A spelling practice sheet will be given out with your Orange Spelling Practice book every Thursday except the Thursday before a school holiday. This book needs to be brought back to school on the following Thursday.
Reading Expectations:	Read for 15-20 minutes each day. Reading records will be checked at least once every 2 weeks. A weekly comprehension will be given out on Thursday and needs to be returned to your teacher on the following Wednesday.
Maths Expectations:	Times tables should be consolidated and learnt weekly. Children should use TT Rockstars. A weekly maths activity, relating to current learning, will be issued on Thursday and returned to your teacher on the following Wednesday.
Dedicating time each day to homework helps you to share your learning with your families and also to form effective learning habits.	

How to set out your Homework

Maths:

Write the date at the top of the page and underline. If the sheet has a title, please copy the title underneath the date and underline. Show your working out and write the answer clearly.

Reading Comprehension:

Write the date at the top of the page and underline. If the sheet has a title, please copy the title underneath the date and underline. Write the question number in the margin. Write your answer neatly in a full sentence.

Please <u>do not stick</u> in any sheets. Bring your homework in on Wednesdays as well as your wallet containing the Homework sheets. We will recycle your homework sheets each week before giving you your next week's homework.

If you need any help with your homework or have any questions, please speak to your teacher before Wednesdays. Parents can email teachers with any questions.

Optional Topic task:

Over the course of the Spring term, up until the Easter Holidays, you may choose to do one of the following tasks (on top of your weekly maths, comprehension and spelling homework):
