Year 1 Curricular Goals

Maths

Number: count, write and use numbers to 100 including counting in multiples of 2, 5 and 10

Vocabulary: Use mathematical vocabulary to compare, and describe mass, capacity and volume.

Reading

Phonics: Recognise graphemes and blend sounds to read unfamiliar words.

Recognise: Read many common exception words.

Understand: Understand books that have been read by themselves or others by predicting what will happen next, discussing events and correcting inaccurate reading.

Questioning: asking and answering questions and start to make inferences

Writing and SPaG

Write: Write from memory simple sentences dictated by the teacher that include words taught so far.

Narratives: Write a sequence of stories to for short narratives both fiction and non-fiction.

Punctuation: Use capital letters and full stops and begin to punctuate work using question and exclamation marks.

Science

Ask: Ask simple questions.

Perform: Perform simple experiments and tests.

Record: Observe and record data from experiments and use this to answer questions.

Religious Education

Stories: Recall a variety of religious stories.

Belief: Give some examples of how stories and beliefs influence behaviour of believers

Discuss: Take part in discussions about experiences using some religious knowledge gained and express own opinions.

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Year 1 Curricular Goals

Geography and History

Questioning: Ask some simple geographic questions.

Order: Place simple historical events in chronological order.

Art and DT

Record: create artwork through observations and experiences

Origins: Explain where some foods come from.

Computing

E-safety: Understand where to go for help or concerns about content of contact on the internet or other online technologies.

Effective Use: Begin to organise, store and manipulate digital content.

Coding: Predict the behaviour of simple programs

Music

Rhythm: Listen to, copy and repeat a simple rhythm or melody.

Physical Education

Movement: Jump for height and distance.

Skills: throw underarm and catch with some accuracy.

PSHE

Feelings: Give examples of how to deal with 'not so good' feelings and how to help others to do this.

Explain: give explanations as to why things can seem unfair to others.

Understand: Give examples of caring for self and the environment at school and at

home.
