# Parents' Guide to Uniform at SMFR Including Price List

### Why wear a uniform?

Wearing a uniform creates a sense of belonging to the SMFR family. It teaches children to dress smartly and take pride in their appearance.

### Parent's role:

Dressing each morning is part of preparation for the day ahead. It is important parents encourage & support this so that children are in the right mind set for learning & success.

## **School Uniform Requirements**

- White shirt, blouse or polo shirt
- Grey/black shorts, trousers, skirt or dress
- Royal blue sweatshirt/cardigan, with or without school logo
- Grey/white/black socks or tights
- Black school shoes or black trainers (preferably with velcro) (No heels)
- Tie (elasticated in KS1) and 39" in KS2

# **Optional & Weather Dependent**

- School cap
- Blue and white gingham dress

## PE Kit

- School PE Shirt (White t-shirts still acceptable Sept 2023)
- White t-shirt
- Black/Navy shorts
- Trainers for outside PE
- Black/Navy jogging bottoms for colder weather
- Royal blue v-neck sweatshirt, with or without school logo

#### Year 5 & 6 Children need an additional sports kit for lunchtime sports

#### Hair

- Hair styles should be appropriate for school
- Shoulder length hair must be tied back

Hair accesssories with flowers, large bows etc are not part of school uniform

#### Jewellery:

 Jewellery must not be worn. However, if your child has pierced ears, small plain stud earrings may be worn. These will be taped over during PE.
Nail varnish should not be worn in school.







# Cost

There is no obligation to purchase any uniform from the school office. Many high street shops & supermarkets sell suitable clothing. However should you wish to purchase school merchandise the following prices apply:

### How do I pay for uniform?
