Reading Curricular Goals

EYFS

Read: Read a range of texts

Understand: Show understanding of a range of texts by retelling them in their own words

Year 1

Phonics: Recognise graphemes and blend sounds to read unfamiliar words.

Recognise: Read many common exception words.

Understand: Understand books that have been read by themselves or others by predicting what will happen next, discussing events and correcting inaccurate reading.

Questioning: asking and answering questions and start to make inferences

Year 2

Fluency: Read age appropriate books increasingly fluently to allow focus on understanding **Questioning**: Ask and answer questions about a book they have read to clarify understanding and make links.

Discuss: Take part in discussions about books, listening and responding to thoughts of others.

Retrieve and record: information form non-fiction texts

Year 3

Texts: Read a wide range of texts across a range of genre including poetry, plays and non-fiction texts

Inference: Begin to infer characters feelings thoughts and motives from their actions and use evidence from the text to support their ideas.

Retrieve and Record: retrieve and record information from non-fiction texts.

Year 4

Understanding: apply growing knowledge of root words, prefixes and suffixes to read and understand the meaning of new words.

Dictionaries: Use dictionaries to support understanding of new words.

Summarise: independently identify the themes from more than one paragraph and summarise events in their own words.

Year 5

Understanding: read and understand a range of new, age appropriate, language.

Recommendations: provide reading recommendations to peers and give clear reasons for choices.

Understanding: make comparisons with and across books

Year 6

Understanding: Read and understand a range of expected new words

Quotations: identify main ideas and key details from more than one paragraph and use quotations for

illustration.

Justification: infer character feelings, though and emotions based on their actions..

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Writing and SPaG Curricular Goals

EYFS

Write: write simple sentences that can be read by themselves and others

Year 1

Write: Write from memory simple sentences dictated by the teacher that include words taught so far.

Narratives: Write a sequence of stories for short narratives (both fiction and non-fiction).

Punctuation: Use capital letters and full stops and begin to punctuate work using question and exclamation marks.

Year 2

Phonics: use Phonetic knowledge to support spelling by segmenting words into learnt phonemes and learning new ways of spelling phonemes.

Purpose: write for different purposes.

Improve: amend and improve work by checking own work for spelling, grammar and punctuation. Add, and improve words and phrases in discussion with the teacher.

Punctuation: use apostrophes for omission and possession

Tenses: Use present and past tense correctly with increasing consistency.

Year 3

Memory: Write from memory simple sentences read to them that include words and punctuation taught so far.

Create: create narratives that include settings, character and plot.

Punctuation: use speech accurately in writing.

Expression: express time place and cause in writing.

Structure: introduction to paragraphs as a way to group related material.

Year 4

Create: Create narratives with consideration for audience and purpose.

Standard English: Use standard English within writing

Punctuation: use inverted commas to indicate direct speech

Year 5

Fiction: write narratives which include dialogue.

Non-Fiction: structure non-fiction texts using presentational devices to guide the reader.

Language: Indicate degrees of possibility and build cohesion

Year 6

Narrative: Write using appropriate form and identifying the audience and purpose

Language: identify and use effective and appropriate vocabulary (both formal and informal).

Application: implement all the punctuation taught in Key Stage 2
