Parents' Guide to Uniform at SMFR Including Price List

Why wear a uniform?

Wearing a uniform creates a sense of belonging to the SMFR family. It teaches children to dress smartly and take pride in their appearance.

Parent's role:

Dressing each morning is part of preparation for the day ahead. It is important parents encourage & support this so that children are in the right mind set for learning & success. This also links in with our key values of being responsible. By taking responsibility for looking after their uniform, children can carry this value with them to secondary school and beyond.

Please label ALL items of uniform to decrease the risk of items getting lost.

School Uniform Requirements

- White shirt, blouse or polo shirt
- Grey/black shorts, trousers, skirt or dress
- Royal blue sweatshirt/cardigan, with or without school logo (school logo branded available to purchase from School Days Direct)
- Grey/white/black socks or tights
- Black school shoes (preferably with velcro for KS1) No heels
- Tie (elasticated in KS1) and 39" in KS2 (available to purchase from School Days Direct)
- Ties may be worn with shirts, but not polo shirts



Optional & Weather Dependent

- Blue School logo cap (available from the school office for £6, payment via School Gateway App)
- Plain blue cap (no sports brands or logos)
- Blue and white gingham dress

PE Kit

- School PE T-Shirt (available from School Days Direct)
- Plain Black or Navy shorts
- Plain black or white trainers
- Plain Black or Navy jogging bottoms for colder weather
- Royal blue v-neck sweatshirt, with or without school logo (school logo sweatshirts available from School Days Direct)
- **NO Sports branded/logo items**
- **NO Hooded or zip-up tops**



Year 5 & 6 Children may need an additional sports kit for lunchtime sports

Hair

- Hair styles should be appropriate for school – no shaved-in designs
- Shoulder length hair must be tied back

Hair accessories with flowers, large bows etc are not part of school uniform

Jewellery:

- Jewellery must not be worn. However, if your child has pierced ears, small plain stud earrings may be worn. These must be taped over during PE.
- Nail varnish or false nails should not be worn in school.
- No smart watches to be worn in school

Where to buy

Basic uniform items (i.e. shirts, trousers, shorts and skirts etc.) can be purchased at any large supermarket (such as Tesco, Asda, Sainsbury's), any regular clothes retailer online or in store, or via School Days Direct. For school logo jumpers, cardigans and PE t-shirts, these can be purchased via School Days Direct.
